A water pump has been realized at the Health Center. We were amazed by the way we worked:

one man goes into the pit every day, digs a bucket of





earth/sand full. Upstairs 2 men are taking the bucket upstairs, emptying it and then the bucket goes down again.... 65 meters deep, until the water is found!

And then it's party time!

Then the pit must be bricked up to 65 meters deep so that it cannot collapse.

In any case, the Health Center now guarantees clean drinking water at all times!



Some sponsors have also taken care of the costs for the furnishing of the delivery room. The Lwengo Kids Foundation Uganda committee has met to further develop this plan and to be able to purchase the various instruments in a good, responsible manner.





## The less pleasant news:

Prices are also rising in Uganda. For a large number of families, it is becoming more difficult to buy food by the day.

It is also becoming increasingly difficult to make ends meet at school. Some schools in the area were even closed 2 weeks earlier for the holidays because the food at school could no longer be paid for. And at home, of course, it's not much better....

Lwerudeso School also closed a few days earlier. We are getting closer and closer to the moment when we have to increase the sponsor contribution. We have now had to increase the sponsorship amount for new boarding children to 250 euros.

This is a worrying situation. Fortunately, we are a healthy, well-functioning foundation and thanks to donations that come in regularly, we can occasionally deposit something extra to fill in the gaps.

But how long we can last without your help, we don't know yet.

Of course we have direct contact with Anthony about this and as soon as it no longer works, you will of course hear from us.

On 8 October, the Foundation celebrates its fifth anniversary. A birthday comes with a gift, but after reading the above, you understand that any financial gift is welcome!
