Some education

Because we have quite a few sponsor children in Top Class this year, we would like to tell something about it.

The school year in Uganda runs from February to the beginning of December. Then there is summer vacation, the driest time in Uganda.

There are three kindergarten classes at LWEREDESO School and all other schools in Uganda. In Baby Class, the first class, children come from 3 years old. If all goes well, they will continue to Middle Class and Top Class is the third and final kindergarten class.



Age does not play such a big role because of course we are dealing with children who sometimes have enormous developmental delays due to extreme poverty, poor hygiene, malnutrition, dirty water and poor healthcare. In Top Class we find children from 4 to 9 years old. At the moment we even have a 14year-old sponsoring boy in Primary 1.

At the end of Top Class, no matter how small the children are, a test is taken to assess whether the children can go to Primary 1. If the children do well, a big school party is organized where the children wear real student clothes, including student beret.

Secondary School

When the children have finished Primary School, the basic skills are there. But after that, further education, is important. It would be a shame if the children could not learn a trade, because it is important that they can take care of themselves.

The costs to attend Secondary School are 250 (Day School in Nakyenyi) till 450 (Boarding School) euros a year. We are still looking for sponsors who want to sponsor a young person who is ready to go for further education. Quite a big amount, but maybe there is a possibility to sponsor a child with family, friends, company or church. For parents who now have a child in Primary 7, this is also worth considering for the next season. It would be great if we could help these young people in this way.

On the list of Lwengo Kids Foundation are still 3 young people on hold, so if you know someone?
